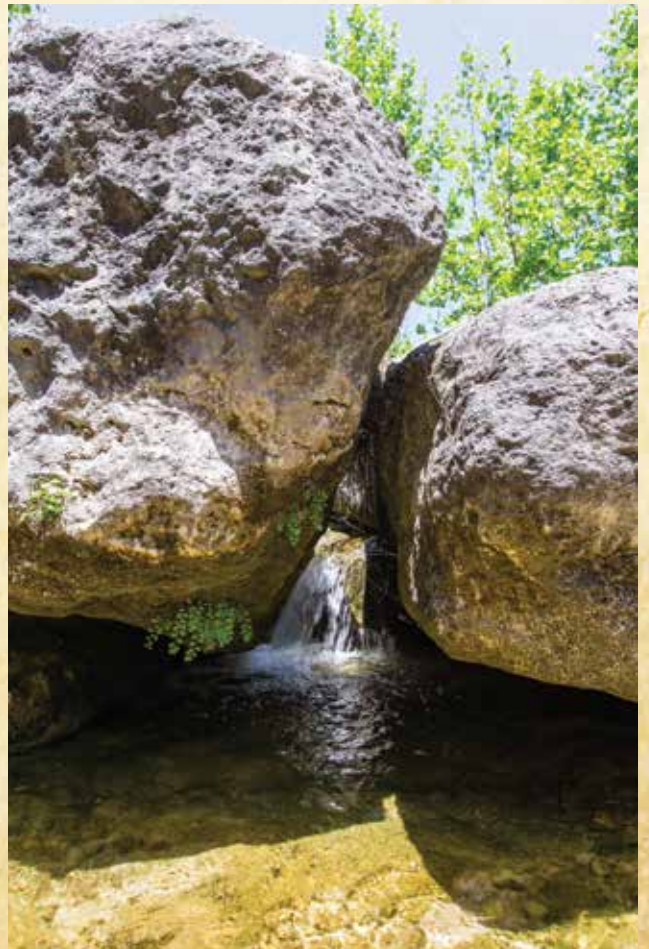


GERONIMO SPRINGS RANCH

2,777 ACRES
BANDERA, MEDINA, &
BEXAR COUNTIES

The 2,777 acre Geronimo Springs Ranch is located just 15 miles northwest of San Antonio, Texas in Bandera, Medina, and Bexar Counties. Live water and breath taking views characterize this secluded Hill Country Ranch. The spring fed San Geronimo Creek meanders through the center of the property for 2.25. Three dams have been constructed across the creek to create picturesque lakes stocked with fish while providing year round water for wildlife, livestock, and recreational enthusiasts. Numerous springs throughout the ranch, including Jack Mountain Spring, provide water to key areas of the property and additional creek beds. Paved roads provide access to all improvements, which include a stone ranch home with clay tile roof, three guest quarters with stucco siding and standing seam roof. As well as, the foreman's house, 3 metal barns, cattle corrals, and game processing facility and walk in cooler. Wildlife species include White-tailed Deer, Turkey, Quail, Dove, Axis Deer, Black Buck Antelope, Fallow Deer, and Aoudad.
